ECC Center will assist students in getting recognition for subjects that they have studied at Vietnamese schools so they can continue their studies in Czech corresponding schools more smoothly.

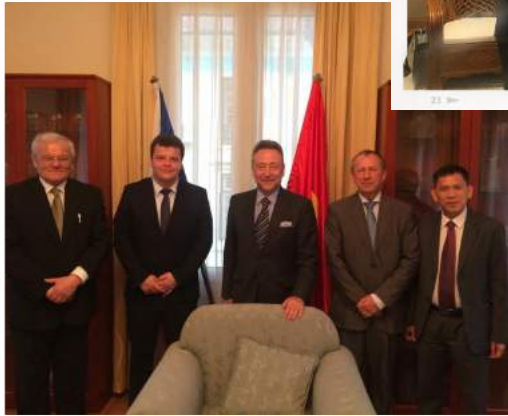
When submitting an application to the Center, students have to submit:
